

Release Notes [April 20, 2012]

1. Added new STAR data through March 2012.
2. Fixed an issue where some stations were not displaying a double asterisk (**) on the Similar Vehicle Failure Rate even though the Station Average was below the standard and the station's SVFR Result was reading 'OK.'
3. Fixed an issue where inspectors with an FPR score would display in red on a Station's Follow-up Pass Rate table even though the Inspector had an 'End Date' (i.e., inspector had been removed from the station's analyzer).
4. Added a 'Standard' column to the Short Term display for stations and inspectors. The Standard column will display a number that is 125% of the 'State Average' for that performance measure, except for the Similar Vehicle Failure Rate, which will display a number that is 75% of the State Average in the Standard column.
5. Fixed an issue where the July 2011 FPR results for some stations were based off the station's January 2012 FPR score instead of the station's July 2011 FPR score.
6. Fixed an issue where inspection "incidents" occurring within a given month sometimes changed slightly from one reporting period to the next due to sample size variations between the reporting periods.

Release Notes [January 26, 2012]

1. Updated the STAR Web site terms (formerly "definitions") and Q&As.

Release Notes [January 25, 2012]

1. Added new STAR data through December 2011.
2. Changed the heading for FPR. The page now reads "Scores applicable as of [date]." As a result, the FPR range for the first STAR report no longer displays "July 2011 – December 2011." The first report for the FPR now correctly reads, "Scores applicable as of July 2011."
3. Fixed an issue where some stations/inspectors who had not performed any inspections for an extended period of time were incorrectly displaying a "No Score." As a result of this change, some stations/inspectors may see their July 2011 FPR score change from "No Score" to a numeric score.
4. Fixed an issue where some stations were not displaying an overall FPR "Pass" or "Fail" result in the "Current STAR Results" field.
5. Fixed an issue where some inspectors were not appearing in the FPR box for stations.
6. Fixed an issue where OBD results were sometimes incorrectly displayed as a Deviation. This change will only affect OBD results as of the three-month period ending December 2011 and any new data added thereafter.

Release Notes [January 6, 2012]

1. Fixed an issue where the STAR Web page briefly displayed incorrect date range (January 2012 – June 2012) for FPR scores that had not yet been released.

Release Notes [December 29, 2011]

1. Fixed an issue where some stations were showing a “Fail” for the “Incorrect Gear Selection” measure even though they were passing the standard.
2. Fixed an issue where a “technical issues” message appeared on some inspector pages.
