Overview

- Simplifies certification of schools and instructors.
 - One certification type
 - Extends certification term from one to two years
 - Provides training options for license renewal
- Updates training standards to reflect current processes
- Introduces training on compliance with laws and regulations
- Provides option for vehicle manufacturer training

Training Standards

Bureau of Automotive Repair Training Standards



Certified Instructors and Institutions

- Smog Check Inspector Training - Level 1 and Level 2
- Smog Check Repair Technician Diagnostic and Repair Training
- Smog Check Repair Technician Update Training
- Diagnostic and repair training – vehicle manufacturer or nationally recognized
- Distance learning
- Methods of instruction

Laws and Regulations Training

- Purpose:
 - Fulfills training needs related to disciplinary actions
 - Responds to automotive repair industry
- Training includes:
 - Compliance with laws and regulations
 - May include service writing
- Would not include technical instruction related to servicing, repairing or inspecting vehicles

Status

- Currently under formal review at DCA
- First quarter 2016 – Public Notice and 45-day comment period
- Third quarter 2016 –Adoption
