# Fiscal Year 2012/13

## Program Statistics

### ➤ **CAP Repair Assistance (RA)**

Repaired approximately **8,800** vehicles, with an average CAP contribution of **\$462** per vehicle

### ➤ **CAP Vehicle Retirement (VR)**

Retired approximately **12,000** vehicles that failed a Smog Check

- 8,798 Income Eligible
- 3,200 Non-Income Eligible

### ➤ **Enhanced Fleet Modernization Program (EFMP)**

Retired approximately **24,900** off-cycle vehicles

- 16,043 Income Eligible
- 8,853 Non-Income Eligible

# Modifying Eligibility Requirements

- Proposed regulations would allow vehicle owners to participate as long as registration has not had a significant lapse:
  - During the previous two registration cycles; and
  - Current registration cycle
- Align RA and VR eligibility requirements to reduce consumer confusion allowing for transition from RA to VR with few exceptions
- Public Notice in November 2013; adoption goal of April 2014

# AB 8 (Perea)

- Extends funding for the Enhanced Fleet Modernization Program through January 1, 2024
- September 11 – Sent for Enrollment

# SB 359 (Corbett)

(Principal Coauthors: Assembly Members Eggman and Mullin)

- Appropriates \$8 million to augment funding for the Enhanced Fleet Modernization Program
- Loans \$40 million from the Vehicle Inspection and Repair Fund to the Air Quality Improvement Fund for funding of ARB's Clean Vehicle Rebate Project and Hybrid and Zero-Emission Truck and Bus Voucher Incentive Project
- September 12 – Sent for enrollment

# SB 459 (Pavley)

- Provides authority to specify the allowable number of days of registration lapse and delinquency when considering motorist applications for vehicle retirement
- Provides ARB flexibility to make improvements to the vehicle retirement and vehicle replacement provisions of EFMP
- September 12 – Sent for enrollment
